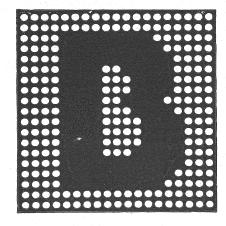

the selectors speak out:

Spring, 1976: The world meets again in the warm colourfulness of our salon. To do the judging for an International Salon is no easy job, but the pleasure of seeing a comprehensive cross-section of world photography is expected to amply compensate for, and indeed, totally obviate the pain; pleasure is expected to take its rightful place.

When the same set of individuals do the judging year after year, they see something beyond the grasp of frequently changed panels of judges,—namely, the changing course of world photography as a whole, and it is this change in trends, which is the expression of the dynamic force that finds visible form in all creative art.

This year, we the unfortunate selectors, were subjected to much torture by some entrants, and at the end of the judging we were left only with a sense of pain and despair. It is difficult to see why competent and even brilliant artists should go on repeating themselves endlessly. Why do they enter year after year, minor variations of their previous successful pictures? Have they come to the end of their creative ability? Is it not ridiculous that dozens and dozens of picture of the same subject, photographed presumably on the same photo-ramble, should all be entered as a group entry'? After all, we can not be expected to accept any but the very best one or two, rejecting all the other similar pictures. Yet again, new artists also are often imitating the older workers, and that is the worst cause of despair. If the younger generation fails us, to whom should we turn for hope? All is not lost yet; some outstanding entries still come in and reach the award list with graceful ease. Some bold attemps fall by the wayside, but not till they kindled a faint ray of hope. Yet, the number is few, -too few for jubilation. That this year, like the past few years, a huge number of studies of flowers covered with bubbles, beads or dew-drops were received, and all were rejected, or that a huge number of nude studies without any originality were received and most of them rejected, does not speak well of the present state of world photography.

The two P.S.A. Gold Medals went to two outstanding pictures,—one a candid shot and the other a 'Contemporary' picture. The first conveys an eternal human emotion with aplomb and novelty, capturing the fleeting moment beautifully. The 'Contemporary' picture is symbolic of the contemporary world—a huge flock of little white doves menaced by a soaring bird of prey. This picture presented no difficulty to us but many others did. What is really meant by 'Contemporary'? Why can not the judges consider as 'Contemporary' a suitable picture entered in the general section? This results in many difficulties, and an important one is, that a picture entered as 'Contemporary' gets an award, but a still better one, which is really in the same category but has been entered in the general section, may get none.

We, the selectors are at a loss. However, the final show, we believe, retains its former standard of excellence and let us hope that next year the stalemate will be broken and new heights will be achieved.

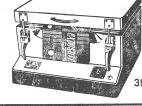

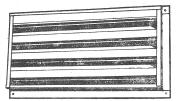

About this time every year we hold the International Colour Salon in our town. Now that winter's stay is over and spring stands within touch we feel that force which through the green fuse sparks the flower. Spring is colour explosion everywhere.

This is the 8th year in succession that we invited everybody over the world. In response 285 artists of 27 countries have sent in 1121 exhibits altogether. And here we project a sample of 210 accepted slides for your treat.

Here you will see beauty recreated by artist's view. Nature and her creatures in so many moods and actions. Things are so different on surface about the world yet so much the same. This unity of existence is expressed through rich colour transparency. Sometimes you will see beauty photographed after the rules of classical art; the elementary emotions of creatures; at other times you will see no image of familiar shape ordered into definite block of hues; but splashes of fine pastel shades. Here you search for the soul's private beauty emerging in abstract fantasy. You may see a bunch of rusted keys or Shakuntala's Ring lost in the tangle of underwater weeds and moss. This is artist speaking in a code language. Whatever, thrill of creation and experiment is here. And you all are welcome to see the trends of photography in 1976. The show over, perhaps we will look at things in a new angle. That is the delightful experience gained here.

As this salon has been a lone example of its kind in India and keeping a high standard in organisation, it has been awarded an annual quota of 2 gold medals by the Photographic Society of America. This is an index to our success. Further, these very slides are due to be shown at Jamshedpur from 29th February to 2nd March and at Bolpur on 3rd and 4th March. This aims at vaster spectators wishing progress.

Organizing an event of such scale calls for true lovers of Photography. So I do homage to the eminent judges Sri B K. Sinha, Sri Benu Sen frps, efiap, fnpas, and Sri Subroto Ray arps, efiap, frsa for the infinite pains they have taken in selecting the slides.

I sincerely thank the entrants, donors, advertisers, patrons and the authorities of Howrah Medical Club the metropolitan newspapers and magazines, Akashvani, Calcutta T. V. Centre, Ghosal Bagan Sangha, The Bolpur Town Club, The Bihar Photographic Society, Jamshedpur for their councels and co-operation Sreemati Rita Dey for the melodious voice in the commentary.

At last to my society members who have been especially painstaking, and to you all for the privileges of welcoming, I stand in gratitude.
